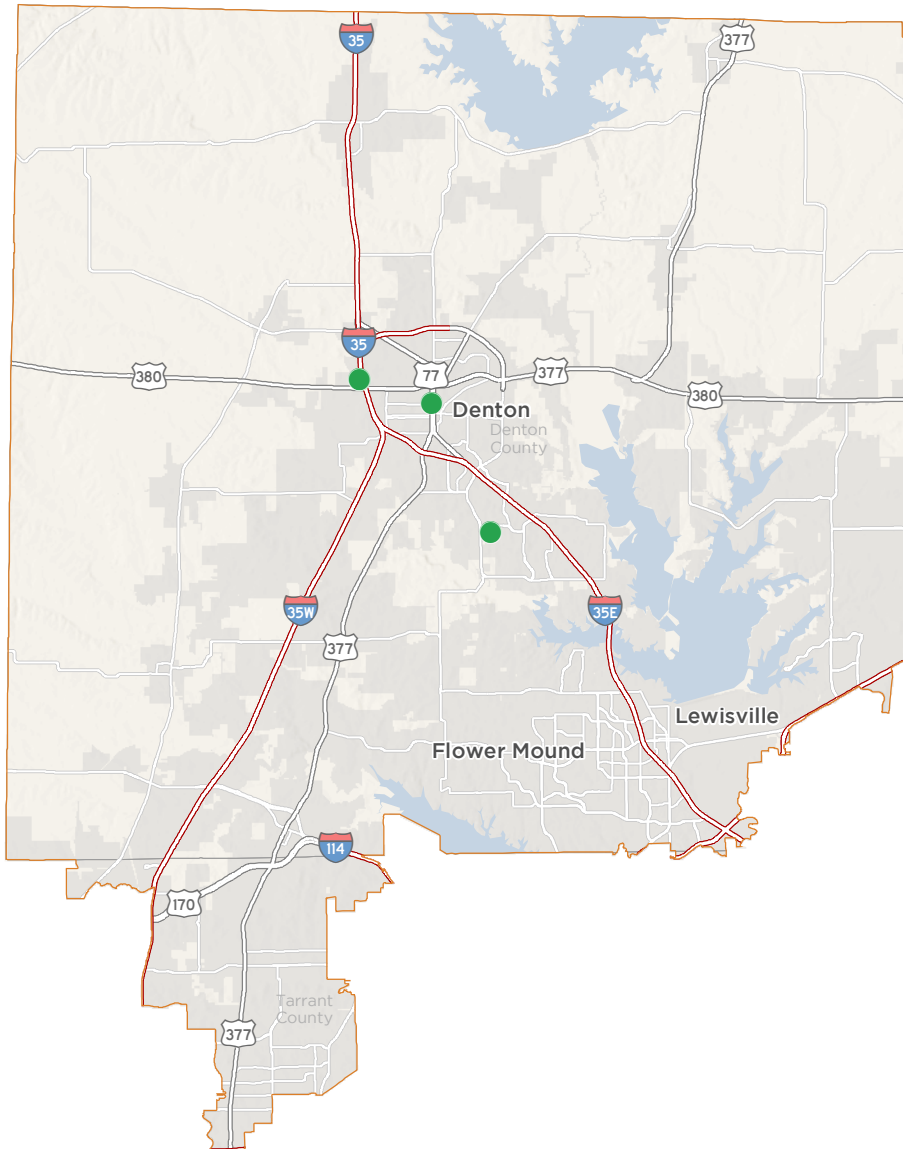




For over fifty years, America's Community Health Centers have delivered high-quality, affordable, primary and preventive health care to underserved patients and communities.
