The 5 Public Policy and Research departments work together to to preserve, strengthen, and expand the health center system of care. Actions at one policy level impact the whole chain.



Advances CHC agenda on Capitol Hill, directly with Congressional offices and in partnership with stakeholders and coalitions.



Analyzes and works to influence policy activities of the White House, CMS, and HRSA. Disseminates information on and provides assistance to health centers and Primary Care Associations on these policies.



Conducts research and disseminates evidence on health centers' role in increasing access to high quality, cost effective care. Also supports health centers, Primary Care Associations, and Health Center Controlled Networks capacity to document and address social determinants.



Develops advocacy strategy and executes advocacy plan to support and impact federal, state, and local policy priorities.



Analyzes and disseminates information about state policy issues affecting health centers. Provides assistance at the state level, and facilitates a virtual policy learning network for Primary Care Associations.
