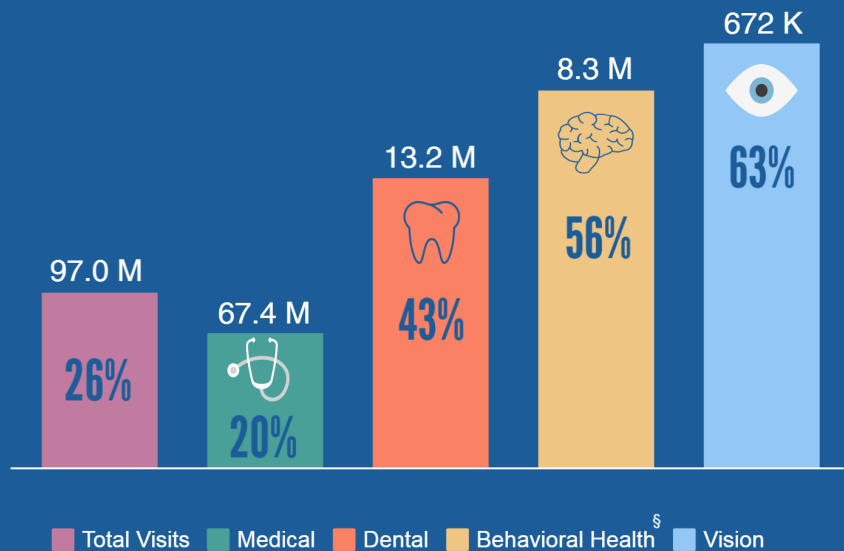

Since 2010, investments in the Health Center Program have increased health centers' capacity to serve more patients and broaden the care provided to all patients, especially behavioral health services such as treatment for opioid addiction, care for depression, and other substance abuse and mental health needs.
