



Purpose: This tool is designed to allow entity leaders to have a framework to help guide the written documentation of 340B savings.

Instructions:

1. Answer the question in the left column with a written response in the right column.
2. Read the sample use of savings statements.
3. Circle aspects of the sample savings statements that align with your entity's mission.
4. Draft your own statement documenting the use of 340B savings.

Question	Response
1. Write the mission of your organization. 2. Compare it to the intent statement for the 340B Program. <i>(The 340B Program enables covered entities to stretch scarce Federal resources as far as possible, reaching more eligible patients and providing more comprehensive services.)</i> 3. Circle or underline common elements in both statements.	
4. List the benefits (products, programs, services, staff, etc.) 340B enables your organization to offer. It might be helpful to also consider which programs would have to disappear if the 340B Program no longer existed. 5. Write the approximate annual dollar value to the entity/patients next to each benefit.	
6. How much does participation in the 340B Program save (or provide to) your entity and its patients annually?	

SAMPLE STATEMENT: [Entity Name] saves approximately \$X/year due to 340B participation, and uses this savings to provide care to more patients and to provide more comprehensive services. This aligns with our entity's mission, as our organization aims to provide access to care for all patients, regardless of income. Examples of activities undertaken as a direct result of 340B participation and the approximate collective value they offer to our entity and patients include:

1. Subsidized prescriptions via sliding fees (\$X)
2. Provides clinical services to approximately X patients (\$X)
3. Administrative support for manufacturers' patient assistance programs (\$X)
4. Operating expenses of outpatient/free clinic pharmacy (\$X)
5. Administrative and clinical support for medication therapy management (\$X)
