PRAPARE Engagement and Innovations Awards Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) As of September 27, 2018

1. How will applications be reviewed and scored?

A panel of six reviewers who represent the national PRAPARE project staff will review applications. Applications for Round 2 of the Engagement and Innovations Awards will be scored based on the following scoring matrix:

•	ORGANIZATIONAL DESCRIPTION AND CAPACITY SECTION	32 points
•	PLAN, APPROACH, AND INNOVATION SECTION	56 points
•	ABILITY TO SPREAD SECTION	12 points
Total		100 points

2. Are there other criteria that make applicants more competitive?

One of the goals of the Health Center Engagement and Innovation Awards is to learn from innovate and unique uses of PRAPARE. As such, competitive applicants will have the ability to <u>independently</u> implement PRAPARE, use PRAPARE in unique settings and respond to PRAPARE data for action in ways outlined in the Criteria for Defining Innovative and/or Unique Approaches of Using PRAPARE section in the application.

3. Are health centers only eligible to submit applications?

For Round Two of the Engagement and Innovations Awards, applications are open to all organizations. All organizations currently using or testing PRAPARE are eligible to apply and submit applications.

4. Are organizations who are applying for the PRAPARE Engagement and Innovation Awards required to use the PRAPARE Electronic Health Record (EHR) templates in order to qualify?

Organizations are not required to use the existing PRAPARE EHR templates to submit a PRAPARE Engagement and Innovation Awards application. However, if they are not using the existing PRAPARE EHR templates, the application should state their method of data collection and plans to build that method of data collection to ensure that the organizations will still be collecting structured data in the EHR that can be aggregated. We are currently working with the following vendors to build new PRAPARE EHR templates: Greenway Success EHS, Allscripts and Athena.

5. How many rounds of the PRPAPRE Engagement and Innovations Awards will there be?

There will be two rounds of the PRAPARE Engagement Awards. Round One concluded July 2018. Round Two will occur between November 2018 – July 2019. Five organizations will be awarded in Round Two.

6. What are the expectations of the organization awardees?

PRAPARE Engagement and Innovation Awardees are required to complete the PRAPARE Readiness Assessment as a part of the application and share the results of with the PRAPARE project staff. As stated in the Scope of Work and Deliverables, other expectations include completing quarterly calls with PRAPARE staff to better understand the best practices and innovations and completing case study questions to highlight the organizations' experiences during the award period. After the award period is complete, we are expecting organizations to serve as PRAPARE pioneers and faculty by participating in webinars and/or trainings to support health centers in implementing PRAPARE in unique ways.
