**To search MyNACHC for a resource:**

- 1. Log in with your Username and Password** -- Your Username is a *6-Digit Number* provided to you when you registered for a webinar or any other NACHC event. By default, your password is the same, unless you have manually changed it. Use the “forgot your password” link to have it resent to your email if necessary.
- 2.** On My NACHC “Welcome” page, click on **Catalog** located on the top bar.
- 3.** For a specific subject area, look under **Topics of Interest**, scrolling down. For a specific resource, click under **Resource Type**.
- 4.** You will see a list of NACHC’s resources. **Scroll down** to find what you need. Note there are usually several pages.
- 5.** Click on **Launch** for the resource you want to access.
- 6. Save** the file to your own computer.
