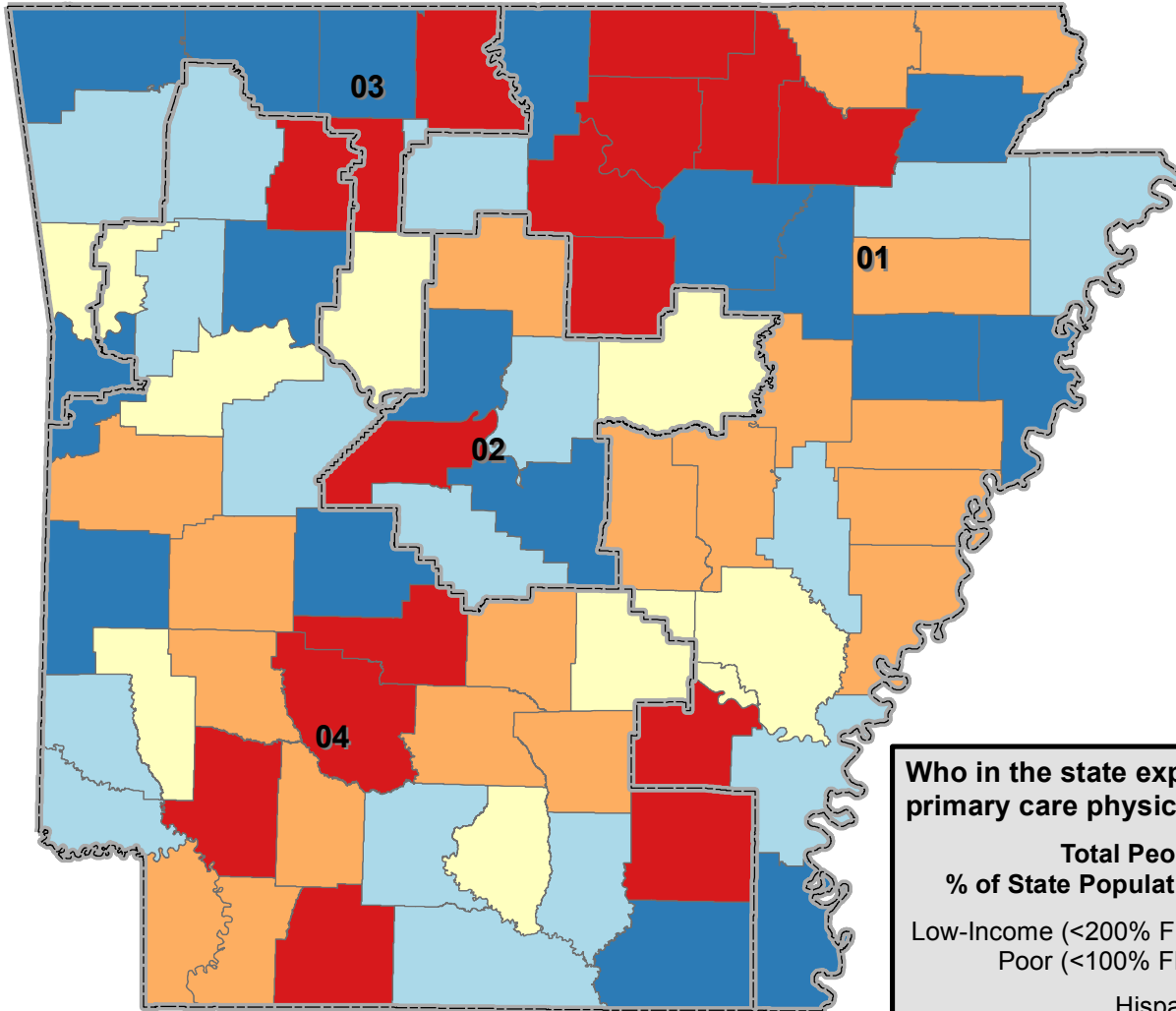


# Profiles of the Medically Disenfranchised: Communities Experiencing Shortages of Primary Care Physicians in Arkansas

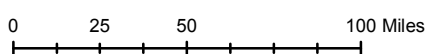
