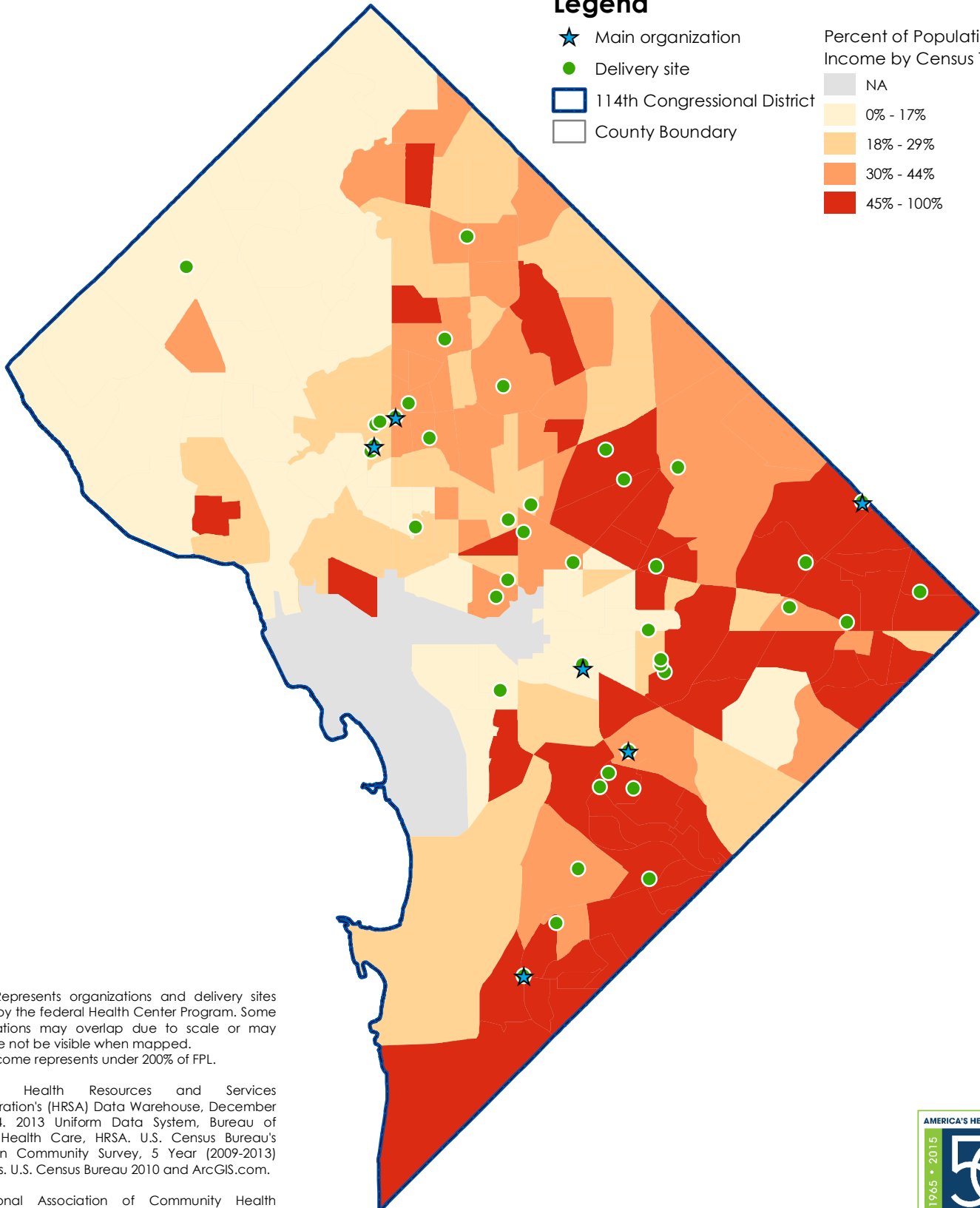
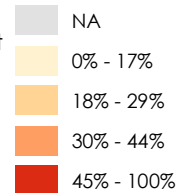
43 Health Center Sites

The 5 federally-funded Health Center organizations in the District of Columbia leverage \$12,484,865 in federal investments to serve 150,671 patients, 17.8% of whom are uninsured.
