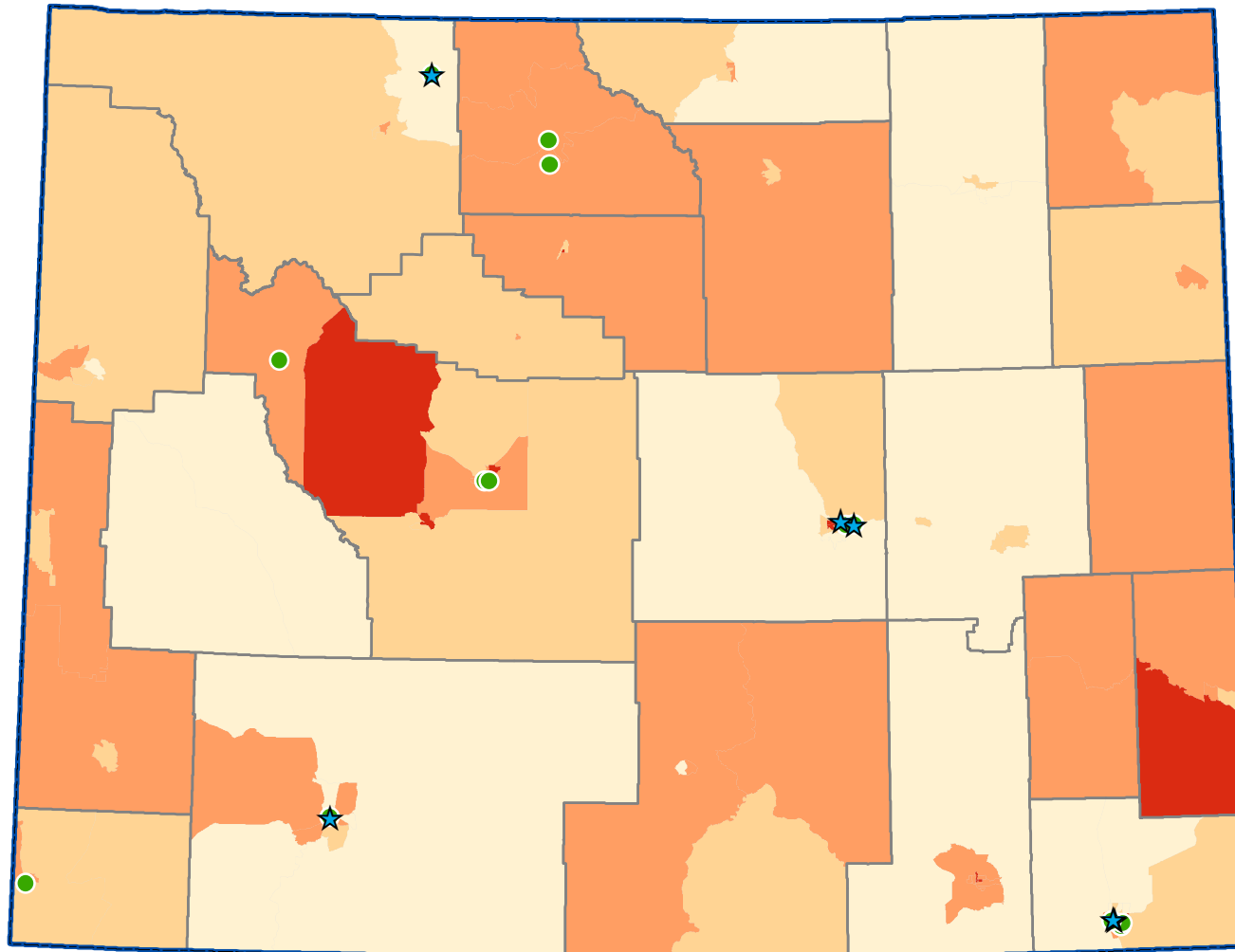




The 5 federally-funded Health Center organizations in Wyoming leverage \$4,390,602 in federal investments to serve 19,896 patients, 41% of whom are uninsured.
