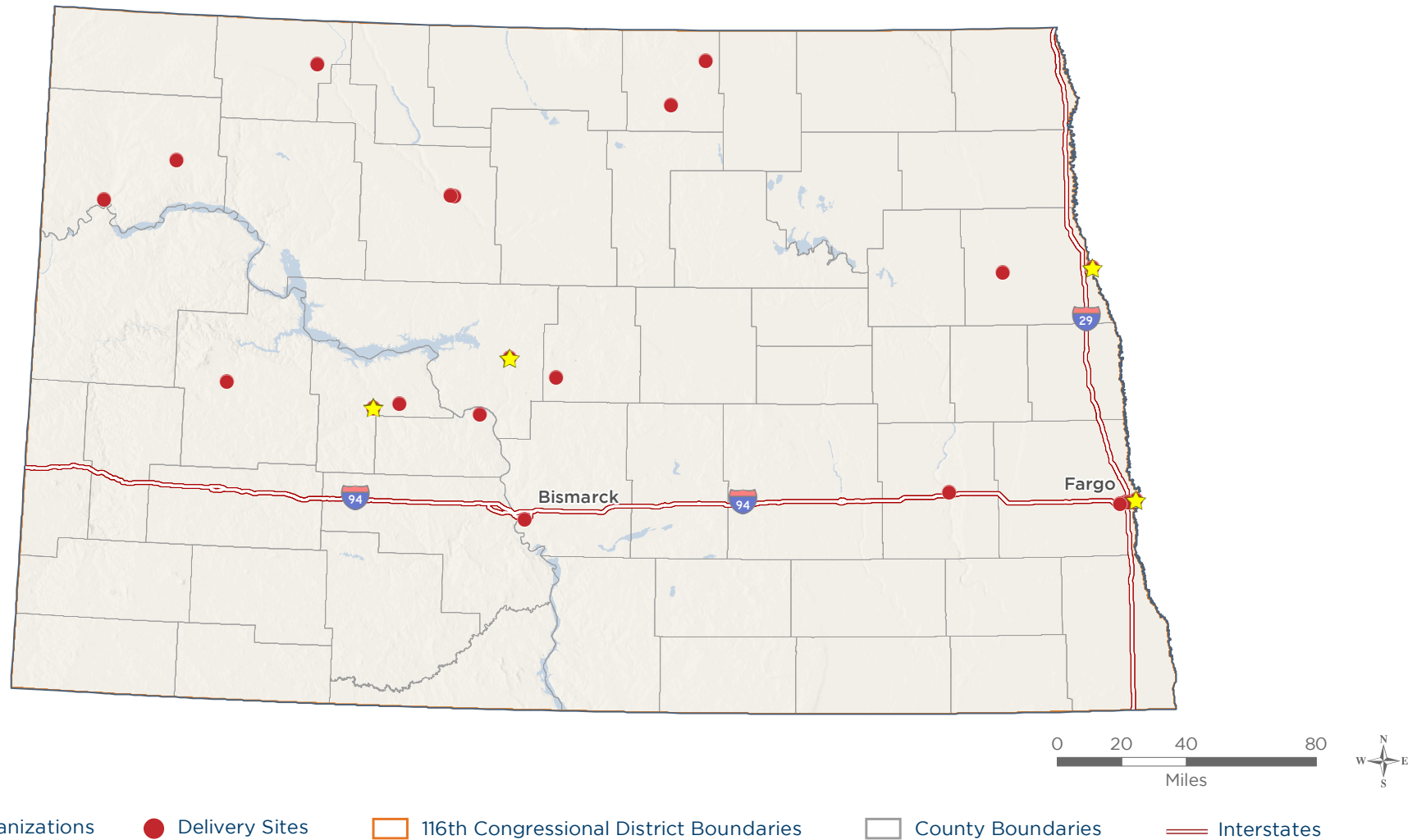


The 4 federally-funded health center organizations in North Dakota leverage \$10,574,613 in federal investments to serve 41,075 patients, 28% of whom are uninsured and 29% of whom are covered by Medicaid.
