PUI Incident Protocol for COVID 19

Triggering Event

Patient tested for Covid 19.

Actions for provider/ HN/HC:

- 1. Report to <u>incidents@ahschc.org</u>
- 2. Notify nursing supervisor.
- 3. Disinfect Room after appropriate time.

Actions for RN Manager:

- 1. Log names of every staff who was in contact with the PUI.
- 2. Note situation while in contact with PUI:
 - a. Was patient wearing face mask?
 - b. What PPE was staff using?
 - c. Length of interaction
- 3. Log all information into incident report.

Actions for QI:

- 1. Send incident report to CMO, ACMO and Site Director of appropriate site.
- 2. Weekly report of "isolation" patients to CMO, ACMO.

Actions for CMO or ACMO or Site Director:

- 1. Review clinical care of patient being reported
- 2. Decide on appropriate level of monitoring for exposed HCP*
 - a. ACPHD did not recommend instituting work restrictions unless pt is confirmed positive
 - b. However, we can make decision based on our evaluation of risk level.
- 3. Track result of PCR testing
 - a. If PCR+, work with Public Health on necessary actions

Proper adherence to currently recommended infection control practices, including all recommended PPE, should protect HCP having prolonged close contact with patients infected with COVID-19. However, HCP in this category are classified as having *low-risk* to account for any inconsistencies in use or adherence that could result in unrecognized exposures.
