Designed for New Board Members

Board Member Boot Camp: An Introduction to Health Center Board Roles

Board Member Boot Camp is an introductory program designed for new board members; it is typically held prior to NACHC's <u>Community Health Institute</u> (CHI). Participants can earn a Certificate for each of Boot Camp's segments. Participants must have their badge scanned onsite and complete the evaluation for each part. Participants receive an email from "NACHC Online Support" which provides access to the Boot Camp Archives and allows them to download the Certificates under the "Evaluation" section.

Designed for All Board Members

Certificate in Board Financial Oversight

Board Members can now complete NACHC's eLearning course on board financial oversight and how to read various financial statements. After completing five modules and two case studies, participants will be able to download a Certificate of Completion.

NACHC Conference Sessions

NACHC typically offers a "Health Center Governance" track at CHI and the Policy & Issues Forum (P&I) featuring education sessions designed for health center board members. Board members can earn a Certificate for any education session that they attend. In-person participants must have their badge scanned after the session and complete the session evaluation. Virtual participants must complete the attention checks during the session and complete the evaluation. Attendees receive an email from "NACHC Online Support" that provides access to the conference archives; Certificates can be found under the "Evaluation" section.

Designed for Board Chairs (New and Incoming)

Board Chair Leadership Program

NACHC's Board Chair Leadership Program is designed for new health center boards chairs or those about to step into the board chair role at a health center. A Certificate is provided to those who complete all five virtual sessions. This program is typically offered once per calendar year. Registration is limited to ensure a small cohort-based approach.
